Native Garden Planning: Things to Consider

Bloom Times- Choose a variety of bloom times to benefit pollinators & provide year round interest.

Planting Area, Sun Exposure & Soil Moisture/Type- Get to know your planting site.

Heights & Colors- Consider placing lower growing plants at the edge of your beds.

Ecological Benefits- Choose plants to attract the insects & wildlife you would like to see in your yard! Consider host plants for caterpillars, nectar for butterflies & hummingbirds, or seeds for birds.
